The SAS is at Passeig de Sant Joan, 75





What is the SAS?

The Socio-Educational Assistance Service (SAS) of the Agency for a Comprehensive Approach to Sex Work is a municipal public service providing support to sex workers in the city of Barcelona, without discrimination based on age, sex, gender, physical and mental health status, functional diversity, sexual orientation, origin or administrative status.

This is an interdisciplinary service that offers social, legal and psychological care in the field and at the office.

What does the SAS offer?

The service offers:

- Information, advice and confidential support.
- Personalised, comprehensive treatment.
- Referrals to resources and services, depending on individual needs, and accompaniment where required.
- Professional advice and support from other services that intervene in cases that involve sex-work situations.

Who can access the service?


Any woman who carries out or has carried out sex work in Barcelona:

- These women do not have to want to stop carrying out sex work.
