The Socio-Educational Assistance Service (SAS) of the Agency for a Comprehensive Approach to Sex Work is a municipal public service providing support to sex workers in the city of Barcelona, without discrimination based on age, sex, gender, physical and mental health status, functional diversity, sexual orientation, origin or administrative status.

This is an interdisciplinary service that offers social, legal and psychological care in the field and at the office.

SARA

Care, Recovery and Reception Service

Comprehensive municipal care service for women, children and teenagers who experience gender violence, and for people in their immediate environment who are directly affected. It also offers advice to professionals and people in the victims' circle of relations.

SARA offers:

- > Information and advice.
- > Psychological and social treatment support.
- > Legal advice.
- > Access to specific protective resources.
- > Job placement service.
- > Advice for professionals.

Who is it aimed at?

- > Women and their children who live in the city of Barcelona.
- > Teenagers and young people in abusive affective-sexual relationships or who are experiencing homophobia or lesbophobia.
- > Anybody in the immediate circle of people who experience, or have experienced, gender violence.

Opening times:

- > **By prior appointment:** call us from Monday to Fridays between 9 am to 7 pm.
- > **If you are aged 12 to 17,** call 932 915 959 or send an email to sara.jove@bcn.cat
- > **Emergencies:** if you cannot call beforehand, come here in person from Monday to Friday, between 9 am and 1 pm. Except for public holidays.
