What is the SAS?

The Social and Educational Care Service (SAS) is a specific City Council service available to women who carry out or have carried out sex work in Barcelona, especially those who offer and negotiate services on public streets.

It is a multidisciplinary service made up of different social education, social work, psychology, health care and law professionals.

What does the SAS offer?

The service offers:

- > Information, advice and confidential support.
- > Personalised, comprehensive treatment.
- > Referrals to resources and services, depending on individual needs, and accompaniment where required.
- > Professional advice and support from other services that intervene in cases that involve sex-work situations.

Who can access the service?

Any woman who carries out or has carried out sex work in Barcelona:

- > Women immigrants do not need to be registered as a city resident or have their papers in order.
- > These women do not have to want to stop carrying out sex work.

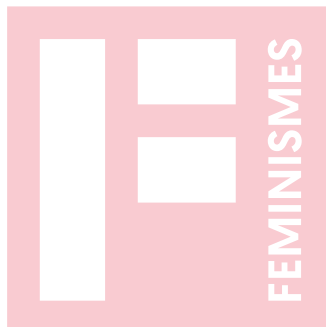
How can you access the service?

There is a “drop in” service for emergencies with no appointment required on Thursdays from 11am to 3pm.
