



Combining guaranteed minimum income and active social policies in Barcelona's deprived urban areas

Editorial: "We are living in a year of experiments", say some people, referring to basic-income experiments or pilot projects that are being implemented or designed in various cities and countries around the world. The B-MINCOME pilot project, which combines a guaranteed basic income with active social policies in disadvantaged urban areas of Barcelona, has coincided in time with other very similar projects, especially the one that has just finished in Finland and those that are still being implemented in various Dutch and North American cities. It is therefore no wonder that the Barcelona project has aroused great interest from academic and research institutions, as well as from researchers, bachelor's degree, MA and PhD students, activists who support a basic income and a number of public institutions, city councils and regional governments in various countries. Members of the B-MINCOME pilot project management and research teams have been invited to present and discuss the project at various local, national, European and international events, including academic events and others to do with designing and evaluating public policies. Furthermore, we have also received various researchers and heads of public and private bodies who have expressed an interest in our project and their desire to come and see it for themselves. As you can see from this list, one of the most notable aspects of the B-MINCOME project has been knowledge transfer, to universities and research centres, to political institutions and public bodies, to NGOs, think tanks and civil-society organisations, or to other cities and regions that have expressed an interest in getting first-hand knowledge about the Barcelona project. To sum up, over 20 knowledge-transfer actions have been carried out, without counting the numerous meetings, get-togethers and conferences held throughout the Eix Besòs area with social organisations, community organisations and associations operating in the area, including the participation of not only the project's technical and management teams, but also, and especially, many of the people participating in the project.

Examples of this include the "6th Community Energy Meeting", held from 21 to 30 March 2019 in the neighbourhoods of Bon Pastor, Baró de Viver and Trinitat Vella, which B-MINCOME people assigned to the active community-participation policy took part in, or the "Creating Opportunities" meeting, which
