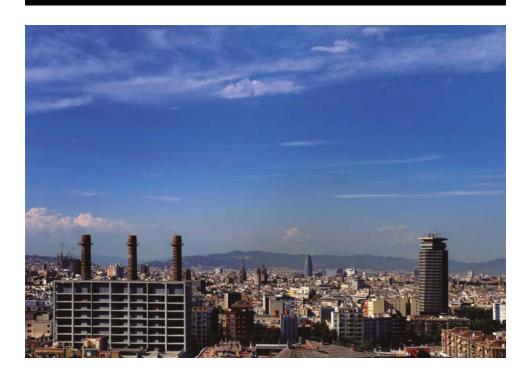

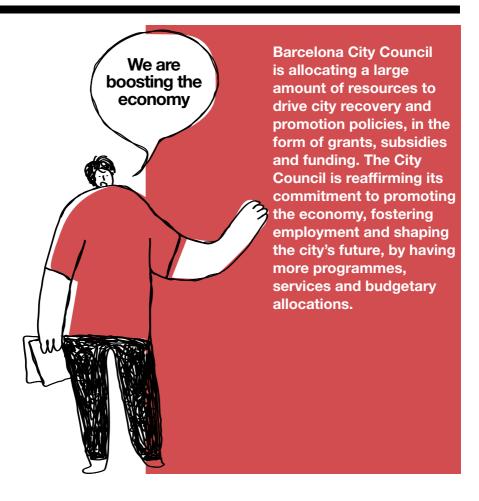

Period

Crea Feina Plus 2023 job-creation subsidies

Incentives for recruiting unemployed people with particular difficulties in accessing the labour market. This year's call for applications will involve subsidies ranging from 2,000 to 8,000 euros, depending on the group and type of working week, for companies with their head office in the metropolitan area hiring unemployed people. A total of 2 million euros are being allocated to the call, which will benefit in particular the hiring of young people, women or people over the age of 45, unemployed for a long time and in a vulnerable situation.











March 2023 (start of the application period)

Activa Autòno+ 2023

Grants for self-employed professionals to lighten the burden of the expenditure they have to bear during their first year of activity. Subsidies will be calculated on the basis of substantiated expenditure, up to a maximum of 3,000 euros. The amount allocated to this call is 1 million euros.

Barcelona Deep Tech Fund

Through its development agency Barcelona Activa, the City Council is going to invest in six national or international private risk-capital funds, for the purpose of driving the city's deep tech start-up ecosystem within the framework of its economic agenda, the Barcelona Green Deal. The 10 million euros of municipal investment will be multiplied through this fund and thus enable support to be given to the city's deep tech start-ups.





Up to 31 Dcember 2023

Locals amb energia – Premises with energy

Grants for energy saving aimed at ground-floor premises. Subsidies will be calculated on the basis of expenditure substantiated at the time of the application, up to a maximum of 3,000 euros, with a total of 9,000 euros in three independent premises.

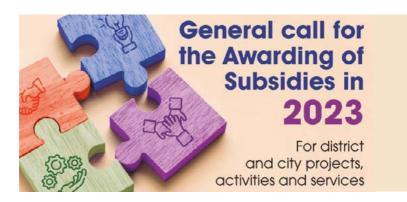
General call for subsidy applications for district and city projects, activities and services in 2023

The 2023 general call for subsidy applications has a total budget of €1,650,000 in grants for projects. The current budgetary allocation represents a slight increase of 0.5% with respect to 2022 and nearly 50% with regard to 2015. In all, the call includes 105 grant programmes divided up into 26 different subject areas.

Enfortim l'Economia Social i Solidària – Strengthening the social and solidarity economy

New edition of the specific call under the Barcelona City Council's subsidies programme for strengthening and reviving the social and solidarity economy (SSE) and developing projects that implement the 2030 BCN SSE Strategy. It will subsidise up to a maximum of 80% of the total cost of each project. The initial estimated budget for the subsidies is 1 million euros.

Impulsem el que fas 2023 – We promote what you do 2023

Call for grant applications boost the local economy. Up to 80% of a project's cost can be funded, with a maximum of 40,000 euros (except category 1 *Amunt Persianes*). It offers 6 categories: *Amunt persianes*, socio-economic innovation and the SSE, promoting quality jobs, sustainable and responsible tourism, sustainable food and consumption, and urban goods distribution.

Subsidies for the digital transformation of local shops, bars and restaurants

To boost the presence of establishments in the digital environment, Barcelona is allocating 1 million euros towards funding projects that invest in digital marketing, websites, online shops and digital signage, among other things.

Subsidies for the Christmas lights campaign

Call for subsidy applications totalling 850,000 euros, intended to give support to the Christmas lights initiative launched by the city's retailers associations, and to help promote local commerce during the Christmas period. The grants are aimed at the city's local non-profit retailers associations carrying out their project in Barcelona.

Amunt persianes - Shutters up

A call for grant applications is being launched, within the framework of the *Amunt persianes* strategy for revitalising ground-floor premises, under a category entitled *Impulsem el que fas* (We promote what you do), geared to generating new economic activity in vacant premises and supporting commercial resilience.

Cooperative loans for reviving the social and solidarity economy (SSE)

Barcelona City Council's agreement with the COOP57 Cooperative, which puts lines of credit at the disposal of SSE enterprises and organisations for investment and working capital for new SSE projects and to revive existing SSE ones. They can be projects for funding investment or working capital and to tackle the need for liquidity stemming from the Covid-19 crisis.

Impact investment fund for social and solidarity economy (SSE) projects

Barcelona City Council's agreement with the Finances Ètiques, Activisme i Economia Crítica Foundation, which has an impact investment fund of up to 300,000 euros to support the growth of SSE projects. The fund look for impact projects in order to make temporary investments in the share capital of the organisations concerned and provide expert advice during the investment period to support their consolidation and growth. The investment for each project will be between 10,000 and 30,000 euros.

Municipal market remodelling and renovation work

The Barcelona Municipal Institute of Markets (IMMB) is driving ahead with remodelling and renovation work on the markets with an expected investment of 100 million euros during this municipal government's term of office. The remodelling projects in progress are as follows: Mercat de l'Abaceria, Mercat de Montserrat, Mercat d'Horta and Mercat de l'Estrella. The aim is to put the focus on plans for improving and maintaining Barcelona's network of markets, with an annual budget of 4 million euros.

Subsidies as a support and reactivation measure for the markets: general expenditure and commercial reactivation measures

The aim behind the call, which boasts a 450,000-euro budget, is to provide financial support to cover the ordinary operational costs of their facilities as well as any extraordinary expenses arising from the Covid-19 pandemic.



First quarter of 2023

Mercabarna Impulsa

The Mercabarna hiring grants programme is intended to promote the hiring of unemployed individuals such as university and vocational education and training (VET) graduates so they can receive permanent contracts once they have completed their studies.

The hiring enterprise will receive a 6,000-euro grant for each six-month contract, provided the established requirements are met.

Call for grant applications for open, plural and multidisciplinary urban-innovation projects that contribute real solutions to the challenges facing our city in the immediate future.

Urban Challenges

Several prize-entry calls will be launched in 2023 for innovative solutions that meet specific city challenges.

An urban challenge is understood to mean a problem or complex need of the city that requires a response in the form of a service, product or innovative method not yet out on the market.

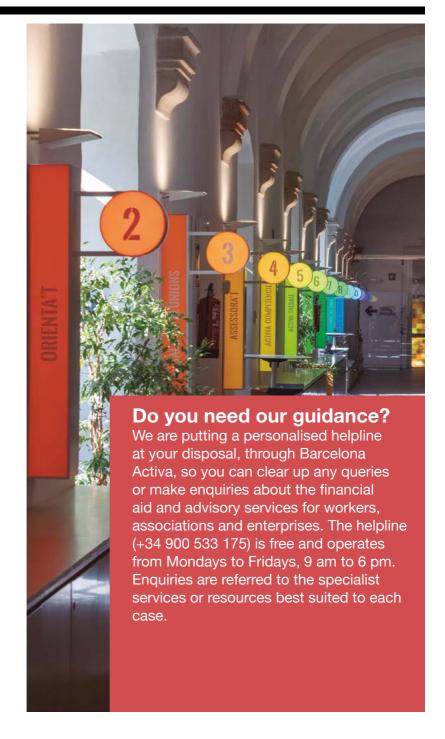
City Experiences Programme

New programme, promoted by Barcelona City Council and run by the Barcelona Tourism Consortium, to support unique projects that are rooted and consolidated in the neighbourhoods, and organised by private socio-cultural entities, with the aim of turning them into a city attraction for local people and international visitors. The projects will be funded with 700,000 euros from the tourist tax.

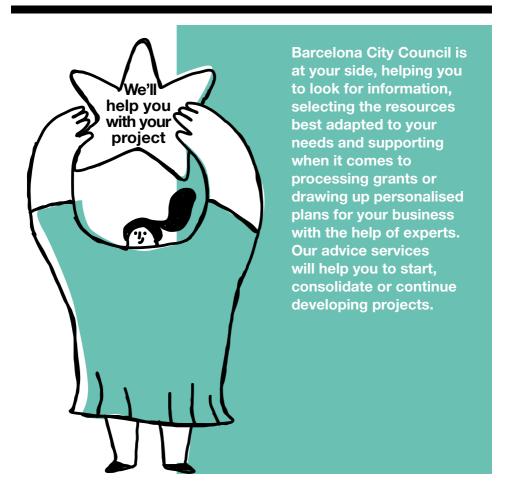

If you're someone whose time with the enterprise you run has now ended, or an entrepreneur aiming to bring continuity to an already existing enterprise, Barcelona Activa offers an advisory service to connect you and facilitate business continuity.

Barcelona International Welcome Desk

Support service for international talent wanting to come and live in the city or who have recently settled here. It provides information on procedures and processes such as work and residence permits, access to housing, healthcare and education, the steps to creating a business, investing or working in Barcelona, and other practical matters for living in the city. Face-to-face assistance is given at the Barcelona International Welcome Desk offices (MediaTIC building) or by video conference. You need to book an appointment.

Web portal aimed at international talent who want to come to Barcelona to live and work here. It includes practical information on everyday aspects of life in the city, a selection of the most important procedures for settling in and a diary of regular activities to get to know the city and make contacts.

Office 22@. Information, advice, and business and urban-planning procedures point

Business one-stop-shop for enabling economic activity in the district. Located in the MediaTIC building, the office offers information for carrying out a business activity in the 22@ district. Preliminary use-plan reports, activity-starting and ending statements, licence transfers and applications for occupying public roads and squares can be processed there.

DigitESSt and DigiDieta

Online self-diagnosis and training tools for social and solidarity economy (SSE) organisations. A series of resources are at their disposal to help with promoting their digitalisation.

DigitESSt is a tool which enables SSE organisations to diagnose the state of their digitalisation. DigiDieta, for its part, is an open and free online training environment for improving the digitalisation of organisations. The training programme consists of eight modules: technology; organisation; feminism; networking; sustainable food; funding; sustainability; marking and communication.

Barcelona Fashion Forward

Support programme for up-and-coming designers and fashion brands. Its aim is to support process and method optimisation, incorporating methodologies for improving their professionalisation, and in the areas of marketing, communication and digitalisation. It offers training sessions, personalised support and service funding.

Ground-floor commercial properties and activities, commerce, services and restaurant trade observatory

The observatory is regarded as an ordered knowledge platform, with data for monitoring the progress of ground-floor premises and activities as well as identifying opportunities. It also contains the main and supplementary indicators of interest to the various groups (internal, commercial sector and entrepreneurs) and which inspire the development of initiatives for improving the sustainability of active premises and occupation of vacant premises.

The functions of this observatory are to quantify and openly share the available knowledge on ground-floor activities and premises, monitor the progress and changes that occur and inspire new strategies.

Urban Economic Promotion Areas (APEUs)

Urban economic promotion areas (APEU) are created to promote and modernise urban areas with an action plan adapted to general-interest purposes. The goal is to improve the quality of the urban environment, consolidate the compact, unified and environmentally efficient city model, as well as increase business competitiveness.

Barcelona City Council has launched training and support sessions for shopping hubs and players involved from the economic sector. It also offers technical and legal advice to organisations interested in continuing to work on developing their APEU project.

Employment rights defence points

Free, personal, face-to-face advice and assistance service on employment rights, available to all workers in three districts and also by phone. Expanded service the covering whole city to meet demand.

Inclusive Employability Services

Employment-information and job-seeking support service for people in vulnerable situations, whether personal, social, legal or financial.

Career guidance and job search service

Guidance service providing advice on the training best suited to the profile of each person and to labour market opportunities.

Employability service for young people

Employment-information and job-seeking support service for the city's youth. It offers full information on training, employment resources and the tools needed to find work. The service is offered at the Convent de Barcelona Activa, in Ciutat Vella, and several assistance points spread throughout the city.

Talent Marketplaces

Events that provide a space for direct contact between enterprises with job offers and job candidates, with participatory dynamics and brief interviews. They are tailor-made for enterprises and also specifically for business sectors.

Pilot service that aims to facilitate and accompany enterprises, associations and organisations carrying out testing activities under real conditions for innovative solutions of public interest for the city.

Business Advice Service

Guidance service aimed at self-employed workers, social and solidarity economy enterprises, businesses and associations on issues relating to incorporations, funding, talent management, transfers, internationalisation and digital transformation.

Comerç a punt 2023

Barcelona City Council approaches shops to advise them on re-defining their business strategy as well as putting their business back on its feet, adopting new marketing models, or creating and developing formulas for incentivising demand. It provides free support adapted to each person's work pace.



From January to November 2023

Dissenyem comerç

Project to revive local trade with contributions from young talent in the creative industries. Various training centres in creative disciplines come into contact with commercial hubs. Groups of students diagnose issues and propose creative initiatives to revive small businesses.

This project enables small retailers to learn more about strategies and creative thinking, and jobs for design professionals may subsequently be created.









Barcelona Biosphere Commitment to Sustainable Tourism

Programme that distinguishes tourist operators committed to responsible management under certain requirements based on the United Nations' sustainable development goals (SDGs). Enterprises and organisations receive training and advice on making an improvement plan and obtaining Biosphere Sustainable Lifestyle certification, enabling them to improve their positioning. It includes training in Covid-19 protocols and access to the Safe Travels Seal granted by the World Travel & Tourism Council (WTTC).

Barcelona Tourism Observatory

Thanks to collaborative efforts between various institutions, Barcelona has a platform for statistical information, knowledge and tourism intelligence offering studies and up-to-date data on the city and the entire region comprising 'Destination Barcelona'. It can provide figures on visitor profiles, their economic impact, labour data from the tourism sector and information relating to accommodation, infrastructures and transport.

Advice for entrepreneurs

Barcelona Activa's entrepreneurship services accompany and support entrepreneurs wishing to start a business project throughout the entire process, enabling them to turn an idea into a feasible enterprise.

Social and Solidarity Economy (SSE) advisory service

Specialised, personal service for providing information to and supporting SSE enterprises and organisations, from how to start a project to how to improve it and obtain funding. Coordinated with the ecosystem's services, operators and players, this service identifies opportunities and detects difficulties, in addition to offering tools and expert support in specific areas.

Digitalisation service for SMEs

Service that accompanies small and medium-sized enterprises and self-employed workers in digitalisation processes. Support in processing Digital Kit grant applications.

Social clauses for responsible public procurement

This service promotes applications of the subcontracting clause with social and solidarity economy (SSE) enterprises and the social reserve that Barcelona City Council promotes, reaching €10 million a year and aimed at SSE enterprises (more specifically, special work centres and insertion enterprises).

OMIC information and advice service for enterprises on consumption

The Municipal Consumer Information Office (OMIC) provides an information and advice service for commercial establishments, self-employed professionals and micro-companies. The OMIC advises enterprises as consumers of basic or ongoing services: utilities, telephone services, insurance and financial products.

Consumption information and education sessions

The Municipal Consumer Information Office (OMIC) provides shopping hubs, district trade councils and enterprises with information sessions to explain consumer rights, municipal assistance channels relating to consumption, how inquiries and claims can be made, and mediation and arbitration processes for resolving consumer issues and any related queries that may arise.

Responsible Consumption Space

This is a municipal facility specialising in responsible consumption and committed to people and the environment. With that goal in mind, it takes part in city events that promote responsible consumption and sustainable food, offers talks, activities and exhibitions, and puts a Responsible Consumption Information Point at the disposal of the general public.













Futurism

A programme for supporting the creation of innovative, responsible and sustainable enterprises that meet the new needs of the tourist sector in Barcelona city and province. Participating projects receive training in the fields of entrepreneurship and tourism, under a personalised accompaniment plan.

The programme is promoted by Barcelona Activa - Barcelona City Council, Barcelona Provincial Council, the Catalan Association of Specialist Travel Agencies (ACAVE) and the Barcelona Hotels Guild.







Starting in the third quarter of 2023

Promoting the 'Zero Plastic' and 'Green Trade' projects

The Municipal Institute of Markets (IMMB) is going to publish a handbook of recommendations, within the framework of Barcelona City Council's commitment to zero plastic, for tackling new and future regulations on the use of single-use plastics, and draw up a repository of suppliers. For its part, the Green Trade project is already present in municipal markets, with 573 establishments signed up to it. The goal is to promote organic and local produce, with guidance from the Barcelona City Council, the Municipal Markets Federation (FEMM) and food guilds. The project will be consolidated in 2023 with a new campaign and selective initiatives for each type of product.

Tech training at the Cibernarium

The Cibernarium offers training to improve digital tech skills and help meet the challenges that come with digitalisation. Its programme enables enterprises to cover their digital talent needs

IT Academy

A programme that enables professional profiles to be reoriented towards sectors such as programming and data science in just 12 weeks, thanks to its self-learning, personalised and highly innovative educational method, and to an expert mentoring service that provides accompaniment throughout the process. It also includes an advisory service and tools to find work.

42 Barcelona

Located in Barcelona Activa's Technological Park, 42 Barcelona is a programming campus that follows an innovative and free model endorsed worldwide and is based on 'meta-learning', which fosters creativity and teamwork and allows individuals to train at their own pace, opening doors to a new labour market.

This is a Telefónica Foundation, Barcelona City Council and Catalan Government initiative.

Online training for professionals and enterprises

Barcelona Activa offers training grouped by subject category and adapted to the needs of each person.

Virtual classroom for projects in the framework of the Social and Solidarity Economy (SSE)

The Barcelona Activa Virtual Classroom has specific courses designed for SSE projects and organisations. These teach everything from how to resolve Covid-19 related queries to how to prepare yourself for setting up a business, improving your skills or strengthening SSE sector enterprises.

Sectoral reskilling

Short-term professional technical training that allows individuals to improve their profiles or reorient their careers towards the city's strategic sectors with higher employability. It offers three formats: online, streaming and F2F.

Language reskilling

Languages today are, more than ever, an essential tool for facing the future. Language reskilling courses are short training modules that enable participants to learn new languages for improving their professional profile and adapting to labour market demands.

Trades Workshops

Training and work programmes for young people whose main aim is to improve professional skills and find work in entertainment and the creative industries, as well as the environment field. It combines a maximum of six months work experience and a six-month employment contract.

(Òh!)pera, newly created microoperas

A project that aims to support young talent, complementing the training of students from several disciplines in the city's creative industries and enabling them to learn in a real environment. Four small-format operas will be designed, to be performed at the Liceu opera house for two days.

Digital Fab Lab Network (XAF)

The XAF is a public service run by Barcelona City Council that provides access to technology and innovation through digital fab labs. The XAF has five reference centres in digital inclusion, skills acquisition and dissemination, which offer people the space, a wide range of hardware and software, and resources so they can give shape to ideas that can really transform our immediate environment.

Fab Labs offer participation itineraries, programmes and initiatives, depending on the type of public and their needs, which are divided into two large areas: educational and community.













Training and accompaniment in commercial strategies for selling sustainable products (local, direct from producers and organic)

The City Council offers tools and accompaniment for retailers who have signed up to the Green Trade programme. The goal is to raise customer awareness and promote sustainable food produce.

Includes:

- Short F2F or online training course lasting 1 hr 30 min
- Personalised advice for 60 retailers
- Virtual accompaniment by periodically sending out useful information

Online training for shops, bars and restaurants

Barcelona Activa offers over 50 free online courses to boost shops, bars and restaurants. The training teaches them how to improve management by incorporating digital transformation processes and helps them to use digital tools to make themselves known, boost sales and increase customer loyalty.

Discovering, learning and finding work ("BCN Guarantee of success")

Programme that offers young people guidance, activities to learn about occupations and tutoring for them to define their professional goal and establish a personal work plan adapted to that. The plan includes vocational training with internships in sectors such as the hotel and catering industries, facilities and construction.



Starts January-February 2023

Training with official employment service (SOC) qualification

Long courses (+300 hours), which include internships and a professional skills certificate on completing the training. This is a recognised official qualification that enables those who have it to change their profession and access jobs with a higher market demand.



During 2023

Job opportunities in municipal markets and local shops

A programme promoted by Barcelona Activa, in conjunction with Mercabarna and the Intermedia Foundation, and in collaboration with the Barcelona Municipal Institute of Markets, which seeks to meet the need for generational handovers in the city's markets. The programme is aimed at young people aged 18 to 29, with or without compulsory secondary education (ESO). Baccalaureate or intermediate Vocational Education and Training qualifications, and offers guidance and training in three food-trade specialities: butcher's assistant, deli assistant and seafood assistant. In addition, the IMMB puts vacant stalls in the markets up for auction to give access to new concession holders. It also publishes the food trades associations that offer job vacancies on its website.

Entrepreneurship programmes for specific groups and sectors

Programmes for entrepreneurship include accompaniment and networking for the creation of enterprises and organisations aimed at certain groups of entrepreneurs (young people, older people and women) or sectors of activity (creative industries, food, sport, tourism or projects with a social impact).

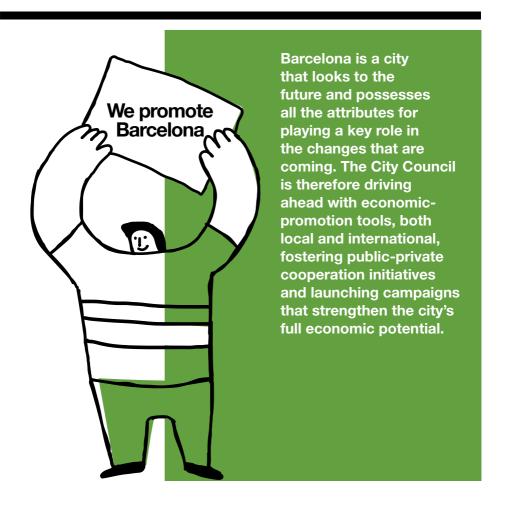

BizBarcelona and Employment Fair

These two are benchmark events for entrepreneurial initiative and job seeking, and they are held together to foster talent and boost businesses. The city's entrepreneurial and business ecosystem will be meeting institutions and professionals again in 2023.









Second half of 2023



Municipal employment plans (comprehensive sectoral and strategic projects with contracts [PICs])

Employment initiative to promote job placements for unemployed individuals that combines work experience, skills improvement and career guidance. Participants join various municipal projects connected to strategic sectors with a six-month employment contract.

Barcelona International Community Day 2023

This year will see the tenth edition of Barcelona International Community Day. an F2F event that includes an exhibitors' fair and an extensive programme of activities (seminars, workshops, roundtables and networking) to welcome the city's international community, offering useful information and resources for living, working and doing business in Barcelona.

Presence at trade fairs: ISE, IOT, 4YFN-MWC, SMART CITY EXPO

Barcelona City Council and Barcelona Activa take part in the main trade fairs held in the city, with their own space offering economic information on the city, advice for enterprises and investors, and networking activities, among other things. Spaces are provided at these fairs so that start-ups in the Barcelona Activa orbit and taking part in its accompaniment programmes can be introduced and create new business opportunities.

Barcelona Social and Solidarity Economy Strategy for 2030: reviving and strengthening an economy for life in the city

The #ESSBCN2030 SSE strategy is an expression of the joint work and commitment of the SSE area and the SSE community to join forces and strengthen the SSE in the city. It became a city agreement in June 2021, creating a joint working space for participation and shared governance between the SSE area, co-led by the Catalan Social Economy Association (AESCAT) and Barcelona City Council, thereby enhancing and giving continuity to the participatory process underway, and contributing to the socio-economic development of the city and its residents.

Based on the roadmap set out by the #ESSBCN2030 strategy, Barcelona City Council drafted the Social and Solidarity Economy Promotion Plan for 2021-2023 Plan, identifying, prioritising and implementing initiatives with greater impact on municipal public policies. Some 21.8 million euros are expected to be allocated to it during its three-year life.

05 Regulatory changes and tax rebates



Barcelona is responding to the current situation of inflation and rising costs - electricity and food, for example - with an expansionary budget and a proposal to freeze public rates and prices for 2023, despite the increase in the CPI. It is also bringing in regulatory and administrative changes to simplify procedures for the public and economic sectors and which will facilitate economic activity.

TREC (e-commerce distribution tax)

Big e-commerce companies, which make thousands of home deliveries in the city and make special use of the public domain, produce congestion and increase pollution. That, moreover, gives them an unfair advantage over local traders. Hence it was felt necessary to develop a fiscal instrument that would enable this special use of the public domain to be subject to tax.

The tax will be applied to postal operators with gross annual billing revenues of more than 1 million euros obtained from deliveries to the final destinations indicated by consumers in Barcelona. The amount of the rate is set according to a percentage of the gross income invoiced by the company, once the operations exempted from tax have been excluded. The amount to be paid by all the operators may not exceed the limit set for public domain use, quantified as 2.6 million euros.

Flat rate

This is a new method of direct debit payment that allows you to pay all the taxes for the year together, choosing the number of monthly instalments you wish to pay.

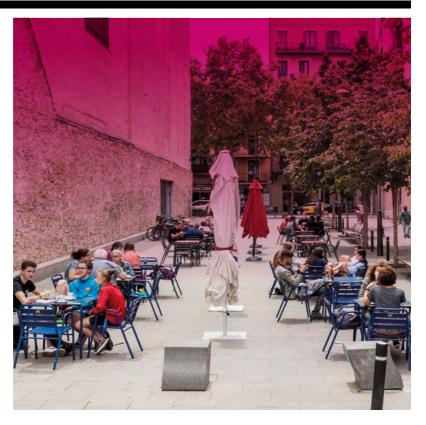

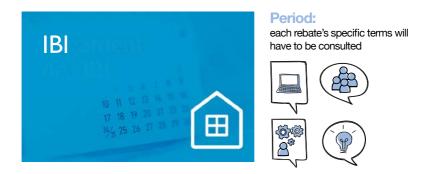

Property tax (IBI) rebates

The City Council offers different: for new-build properties and social housing, if this involves a large family and systems are installed for harnessing heat or electricity from the sun's energy, during the three tax periods following the date of the installation's legalisation.



Economic activity tax (IAE) rebates

The City Council offers different rebates on the tax for business activities.

Rebates for cooperatives

Cooperatives and cooperative unions, federations and confederations can request an IAE rebate provided they present documentary proof that they are registered in the Cooperatives register and meet the requirements set out in the Tax byelaw and Act 20/1990, of 19 December, on the tax system for cooperatives.

The rebate is for 95% of the amount of the tax levied.

Tax rebates for increased staff numbers

Natural or legal persons who pay municipal tax and have increased their staff by 10% or more are eligible for a rebate. The increase must have involved indefinite contracts and taken place during the tax period immediately prior to that in which the subsidy is requested. It must be borne in mind that this increase in staff numbers must have occurred in their work centres in the Barcelona municipality.

Rate reduction for use of renewable energy

Rebates for natural and legal persons installing systems for harnessing heat or electricity from the sun's energy, for three consecutive years as from the date of application for the installation's legalisation or registration.

Tax on mechanically powered vehicles (IVTM) rebates

The City Council offers several rebates on the tax on mechanically powered vehicles.

Rebate on the tax on mechanically powered vehicles for owners of vehicles classed as zero emission or electric vehicles:

Rebate on the tax on mechanically powered vehicles of any kind (except trailers) classed as zero emission vehicles according to the vehicle registry of the Directorate General of Traffic.

Rebate on the tax on mechanically powered vehicles for owners of ECO-classed vehicles that use petrol, with emissions of up to 120 g/km of CO2:

Rebate on the tax on mechanically powered vehicles for owners of ECO-classified vehicles of any kind (except trailers) that use petrol, with emissions of up to 120 g/km of CO2, according to the vehicle registry of the Directorate General of Traffic.

Rebate on the tax on mechanically powered vehicles for owners of vintage vehicles:

Rebate on the entire amount of the tax on mechanically powered vehicles for vehicles considered vintage, under the regulations for vintage vehicles.

Construction, installation and works tax (ICIO) rebates

Barcelona City Council offers several rebates on the construction, installation and works tax. Rebates on the construction, installation and works tax (ICIO) may be requested for work whose purpose is to construct buildings or put up installations declared to be of special municipal interest or usefulness, because of social, cultural, historical and artistic or work-promoting circumstances or because they incorporate systems for harnessing heat or electricity from solar energy.

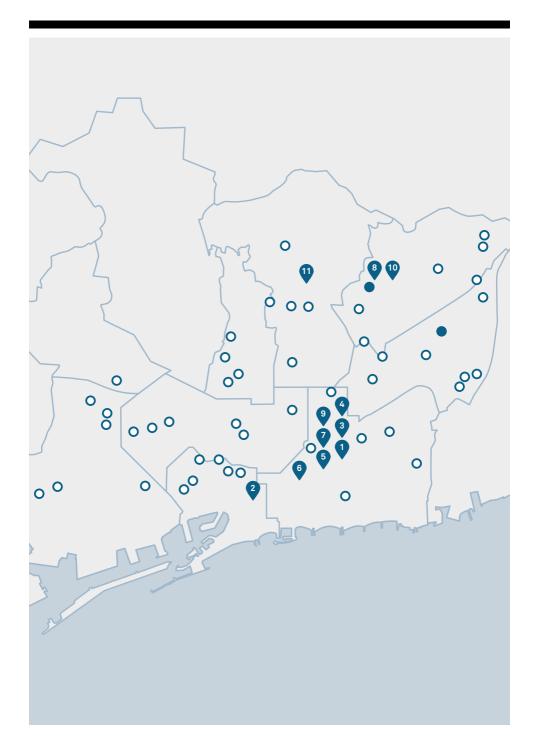

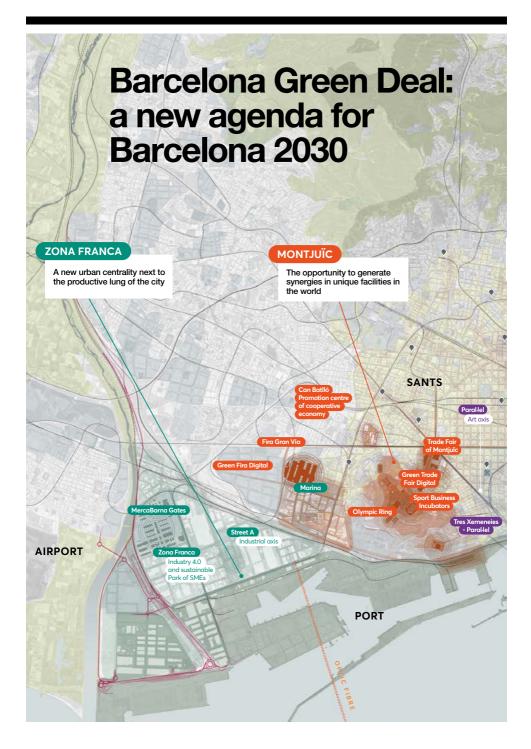

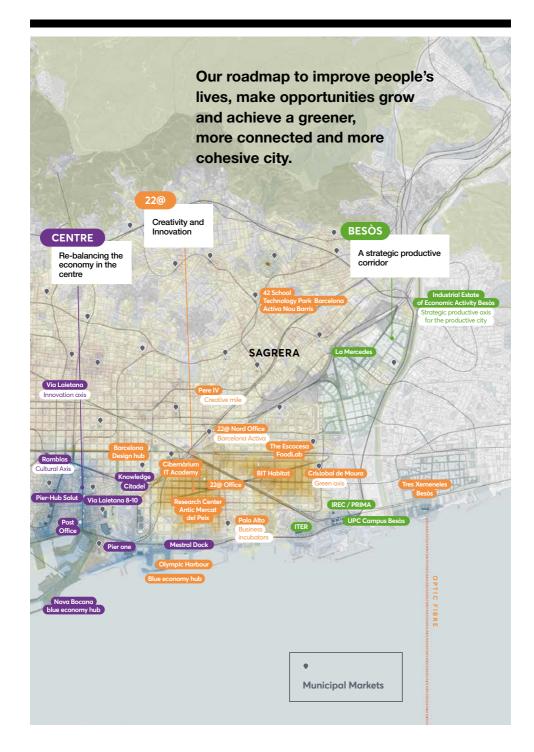
