

INSTITUTIONAL DECLARATION

Coinciding with the 30th anniversary of the Hipercor bomb attack, Barcelona City Council approved the following institutional declaration:

1. Barcelona conveys its condolences and support for the victims of the Hipercor bombing, citizens who lost loved ones, those who were injured and everyone suffering to this day the consequences of an unjustifiable attack.
2. Barcelona, on the 30th anniversary of the attack, recognises it as a painful part of the city's collective memory and one which therefore needs to be remembered.
3. The memory of the Hipercor attack should help strengthen Barcelona's will to be a city which promotes peace and stands up for democratic values and dialogue.
4. Barcelona pledges to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the Hipercor attack appropriately. To this end, an official memorial act will be held and an exhibition will be organised looking at the facts surrounding the attack so that the public, particularly younger generations, do not forget.

The declaration was supported by the municipal government (BComú and the PSC), PDeCat, Ciutadans, ERC, the PP and the independent councillor, Gerard Ardanuy.
