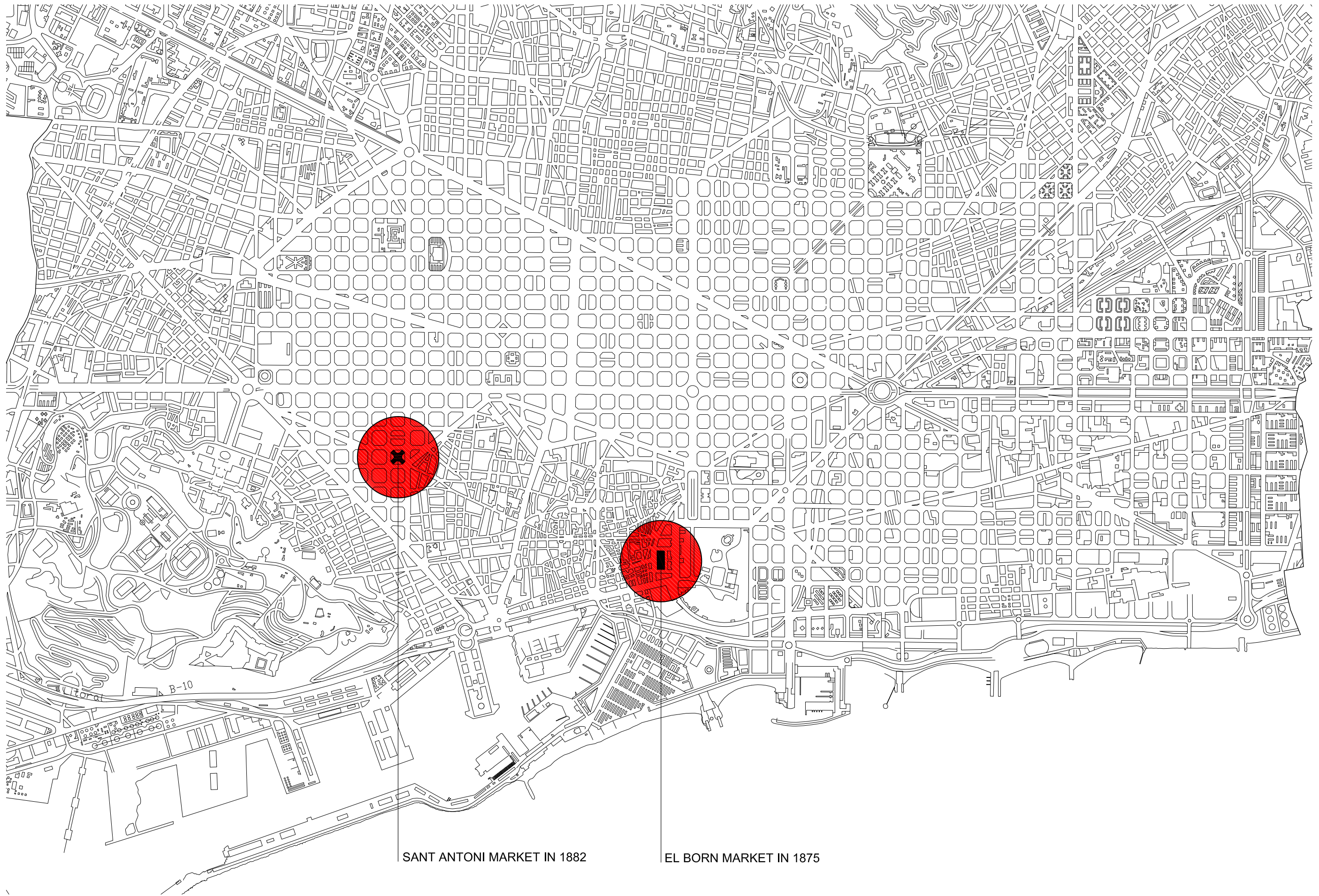

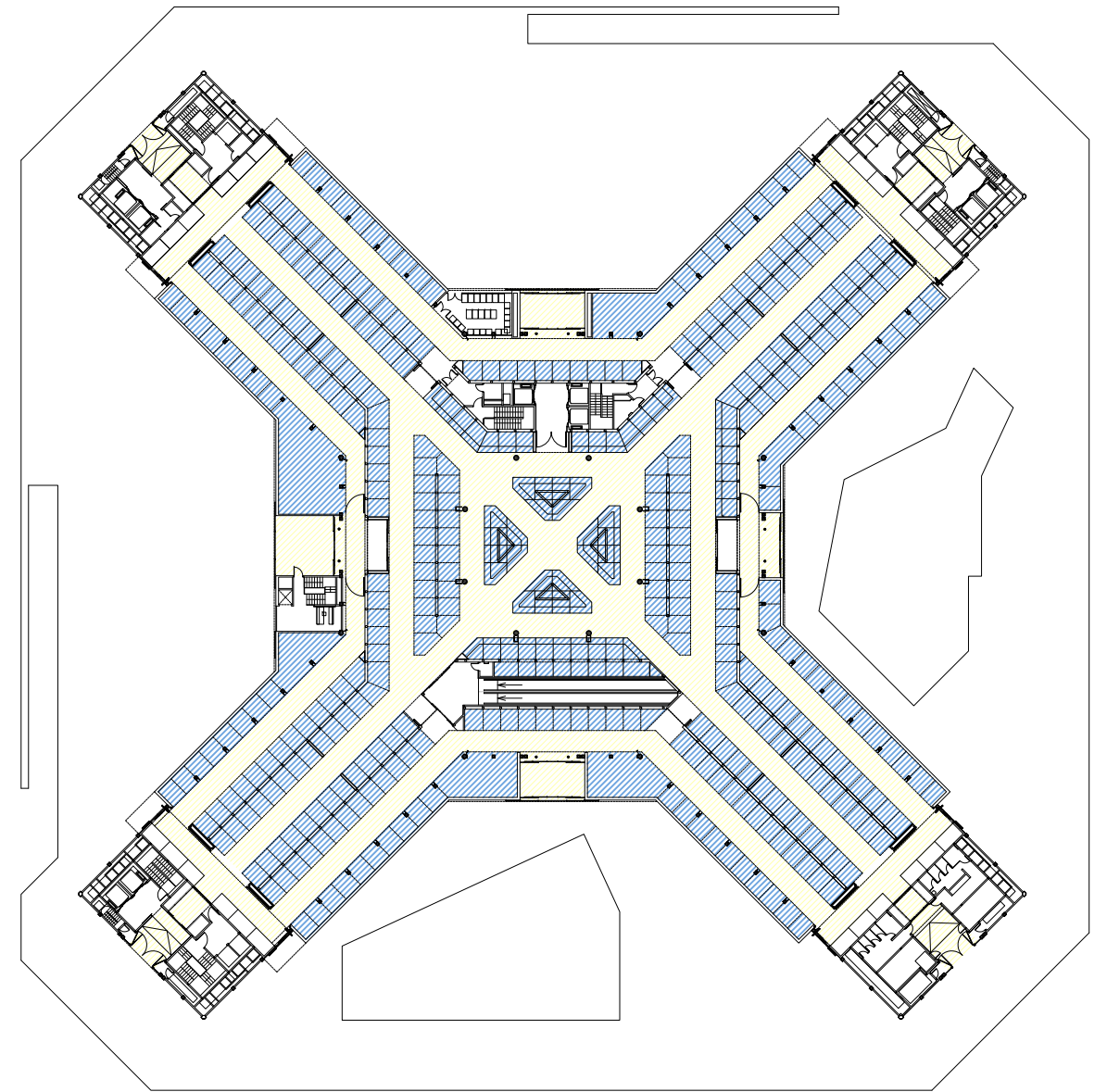

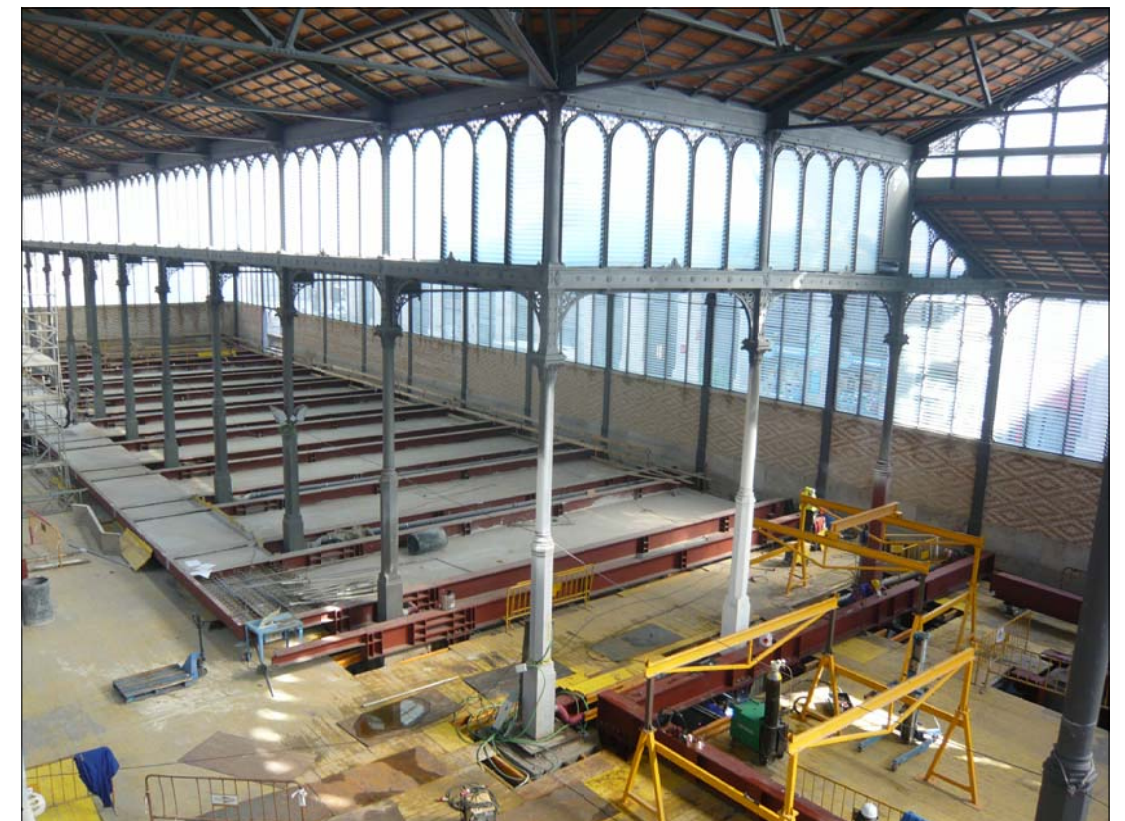
ORIGINAL SECTION, 1875



SECTION OF THE NAVE FAÇADE

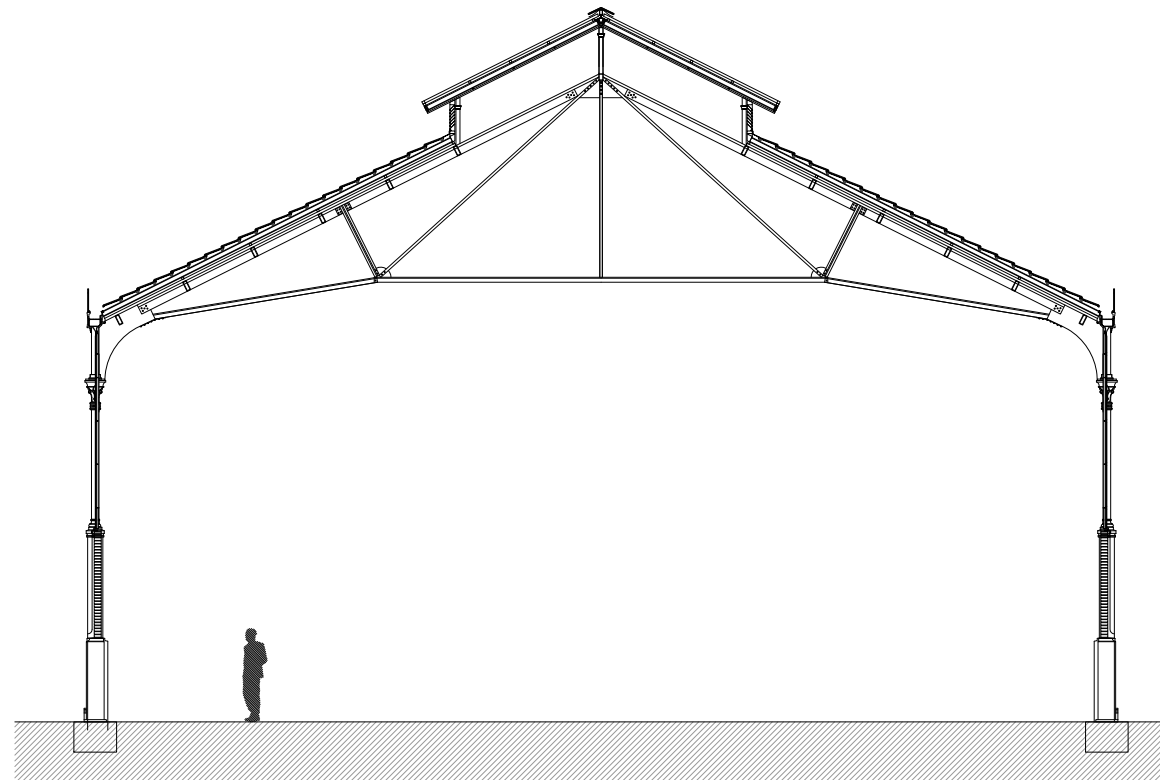

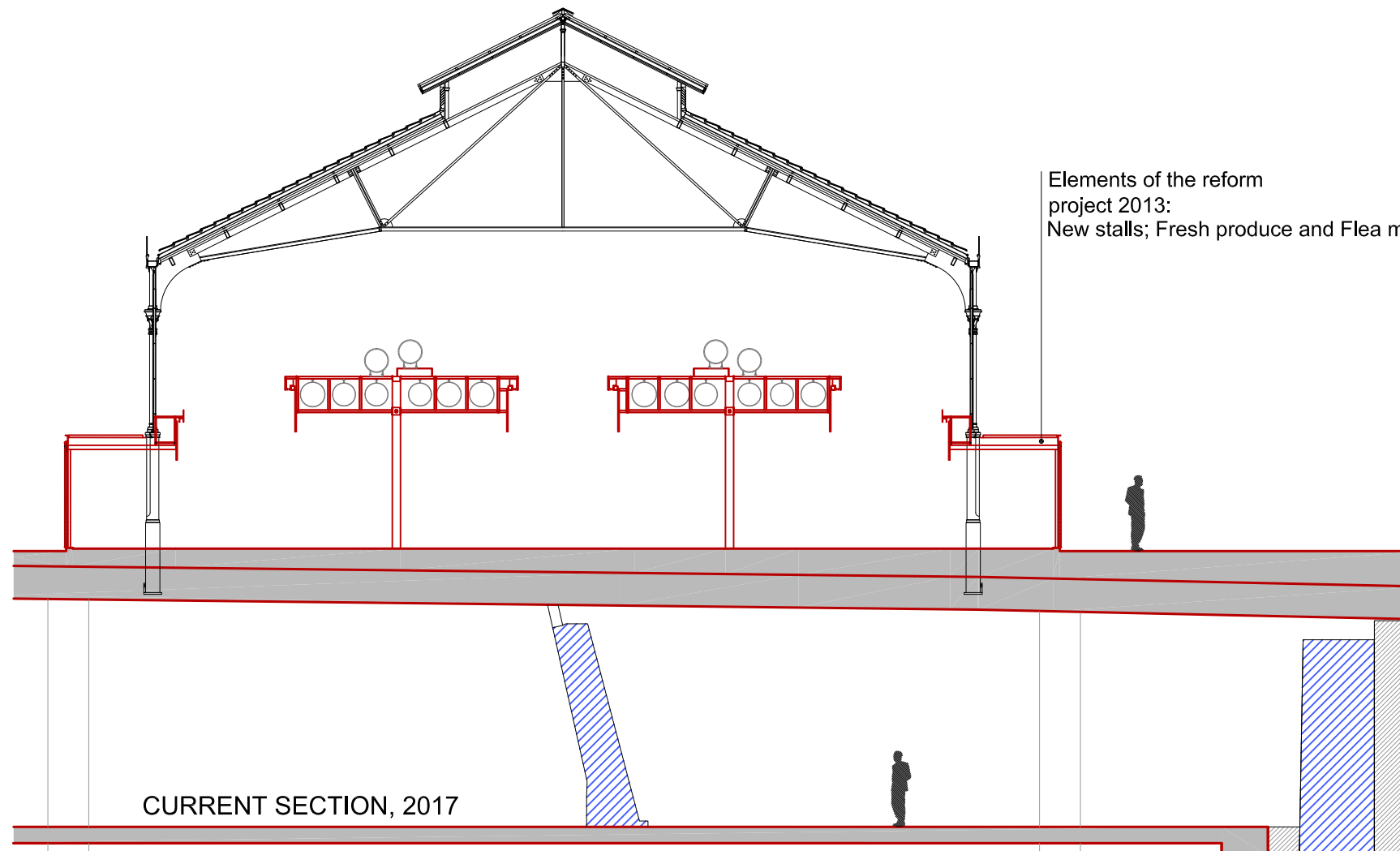
