

NGEU funding for tourism: The PSTD and other funding opportunities





The Strategy for Sustainable Destination Tourism is part of the Recovery,

Transformation and Resilience Plan (PRTR) presented by the Spanish government.

Within this framework, the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Tourism aims to transform, modernise and improve the competitiveness of the tourism sector through **sustainability** and digitalisation.

It is part of component 14, "Tourism Sector Modernisation and Competitiveness Plan", of the PRTR.

The 21-22-23 call for applications has the following funding available:

Barcelona is poised to rise to the challenge of the European Union tourism funds. It has worked for years to transform and diversify the tourism model that has made the city a leading destination in urban tourism that addresses criteria of sustainability, equity and quality. With these objectives in mind, a **Strategic Plan**, a **Tourism Marketing Strategy**, a **Government Measure of New Visions** and the definition of the visitor economy in the **Barcelona Green Deal** economic agenda have been established. The projects submitted are also part of the strategic objectives of the **Barcelona Dossier**.

The city's specific goals



The **goal** of the Barcelona PSTD is to promote the destination's economic recovery and resilience through **decentralisation**, the **creation of new visions**, and **innovation** to ensure the **social return of tourism** and the **sustainability** of tourist activity. Thus, the following 6 overarching goals were set:

To consolidate the sustainability of the tourism model and its compatibility with the city model and the lives of city residents, raising awareness among the actors in the visitor economy

To foster the **decentralisation** of tourist activity, focusing on **polycentrism** by showcasing **new visions**

To encourage the showcasing and creation of new content based on culture, creativity and Barcelona's unique values as a destination

4

To foster **sustainable tourist mobility** that is compatible with the
city's tourism and mobility model

5

To promote processes that improve energy efficiency and mitigate climate change in tourist activities

6

To encourage the **comprehensive digitalisation** of tourist activities and
promotion

Besòs/Collserola: promoting the Collserola Nature Park and the banks of the Besòs River through environmental recovery and historical restoration of various tourist attractions

Innovation:
Digitalisation/Sustainability: creating a turning point in the rollout of digitalisation by positioning Barcelona as an innovative urban tourism

Sustainable Mobility: initiatives for integrating the patterns and dynamics of tourist mobility into the city's desired mobility model: healthy, safe, balanced, sustainable and accessible





